



KEW FOOTBALL CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT – SEASON 2011



COMMITMENT

The Club Code of Conduct has been endorsed by the committee of the Kew Football Club ('The Club') and applies to all of our officials, volunteers, members and supporters ('Members').

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Club Code of Conduct is to ensure that the Kew Football Club conducts itself in a sportsmanlike manner, at all times respecting umpires, opposition players, officials and supporters whilst recognising the principle of fair play and the need to promote the game of football and its parent body, the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the Code of Conduct, members of the Kew Football Club must:

- Treat all players, officials and volunteers and guests with respect;
- Refrain from verbal abuse (including but not limited to swearing and offensive gestures) or criticism of umpires or other VAFA officials;
- Not vilify or discriminate against any person on the grounds of any personal attribute as per the club's Racial & Religious Tolerance Policy;
- Follow the reasonable direction of a Club official;
- Encourage people to actively support their team;

- Ensure that all VAFA officials, along with opposition players, officials and supporters are made feel welcome at all Club games including after match drinks;
- Uphold the spirit in which the game should be played;
- Take all reasonable care for facilities and equipment of the Club;
- Conduct themselves at all times in a manner that upholds the proud and respected traditions of the Club both in the VAFA and wider community and is consistent with this Code of Conduct.


ENFORCEMENT

Any queries or breaches of the Code of Conduct should be directed to a committee member of the Kew Football Club.

Any breach deemed to be detrimental to the interests of the Kew Football Club will be acted upon by the committee in a manner it deems appropriate.

REVIEW

This code of conduct will be reviewed on an annual basis. This will ensure that the code remains current and practical.
